

# Museum of Modern Literature and the Schiller National Museum

## ***Opening hours***

Tues-Sun, 10 a.m-5 p.m. Monday closed, except on public holidays.  
No prior registration is necessary.

## ***Safety measures are currently in place to protect staff and visitors from the spread of the Corona virus.***

Safety masks covering both mouth and nose must be worn by all visitors in the museums.

Max. 75 visitors are permitted in the Museum of Modern Literature and max. 50 visitors are permitted in the Schiller National Museum.

The connecting passage between the museums is closed; all visitors must go through the main entrance of the respective museum.

All visitors must complete the DLA's Corona questionnaire on every day of their visit (download it [here](#); if you visit both museums, please mark this on the sheet, present it at the first cash register for inspection and then hand it in to staff at the cash register in the second museum).

In the exhibition space the general hygiene regulations and distance requirement of min. 1.5m apply.

Gloves and safety masks can be obtained against a small fee of €0.50 each. When visiting the exhibition *Let it Shine! Peter Rühmkorf – self-expressing and self-rhyming*, we recommend the purchase of a protection device (€0.30 each) to place around the headsets at the exhibition's listening stations.

The Museum Café opening hours and menu are limited (only hot and cold drinks as well as pre-packed snacks are available). Max. 10 persons may gather in the indoor space (2-4 person groups from max. 2 households are possible).
