1 DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY

Creator: Heinrich Mendelssohn (1910–2002)

Title: The Papers of Heinrich Mendelssohn

Dates: ca. 1910–2012 [bulk: 1930s – 1990s]

Abstract:

Heinrich Mendelssohn (Berlin 1910 – Tel Aviv 2002) was a renowned zoologist and a pioneer of the environmental movement in Israel. He grew up in an acculturated German-Jewish bourgeois family. At an early age, Mendelssohn joined a Zionist youth organization and pursued his keen interest in nature and wildlife on the frequent excursions characteristic for the youth movement during these years. Between 1928 and 1933, Mendelssohn studied Medicine and Zoology in Berlin. After the National Socialist party gained governmental power in 1933, Mendelssohn immigrated to Mandatory Palestine and completed his studies in Zoology at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. He joined Tel Aviv's Biological-Pedagogical Institute in 1935 and became its manager in 1947. During the 1950's Mendelssohn endorsed and supported the pioneering environmental initiatives, which originated from informal meetings at the Biological-Pedagogical Institute and continued to promote the protection of nature in various contexts in the following years. In 1956, the Biological-Pedagogical Institute was installed as the core of the Faculty of Natural Sciences of the emerging Tel Aviv University. Between 1956 and 1966, Mendelssohn served as the first chairman of the faculty's department of Zoology; in 1961, he acted as faculty's dean. At Tel Aviv University, his research was devoted primarily to Israel's wildlife and to the prevention of species from extinction worldwide. Mendelssohn continued to devote his work to scientific and environmental causes until his death in 2002.

The materials in the collection reflect Heinrich Mendelssohn's activities in Germany and in Mandatory Palestine/Israel. It displays his involvement in the Zionist youth movements, his work in the Biological-Pedagogical Institute as well as his engagement in various researches. A large number of the documents are related to Mendelssohn's scholarly work as professor at Tel Aviv University and reflect his devotion to environmental issues and the protection of wildlife in Israel as part of his activity in the Society for the Protection of Nature in Israel and the Nature Reserve Authority. In addition, the collection displays Mendelssohn's vast amount of species documentation in observations cards, photographs, films and contact sheets.

2 BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE:

Heinrich Mendelssohn (Berlin 1910 – Tel Aviv 2002) was the son of salesman Paul Joseph Mendelssohn (a relative of the philosopher Moses Mendelssohn and the composer Felix Mendelssohn-Bartholdy) and Lucie Mendelssohn (née Ludnovski), who came from a Polish-Jewish family. Heinrich Mendelssohn grew up in a German bourgeois environment and developed a keen interest in nature from a young age. He did not know that he was Jewish until the age of eight, when he was assigned to the Jewish religious classes at his school. Mendelssohn joined the Zionist youth movement (Blau-Weiß and Kadimah) around the age of 12 and participated in weekend excursions and nature hikes, during which he paid special attention to nature. When he started to study at the University of Berlin (Friedrich-Wilhelms-Universität Berlin, later renamed Humboldt Universität) in 1928, Mendelssohn became a member of the Kartell Jüdischer Verbindungen (KJV), the umbrella organization of Zionist students' fraternities. He enrolled in Zoology classes, but conceded to his family's wishes and studied Medicine as well. At the Zoology Department he sought to gain as much fieldwork experience as possible. He participated in many wildlife observation expeditions and volunteered at the zoo. At the Zoology Department he also made acquaintance with Alexander Barasch, a Jewish student (later a professor for Zoology) from Mandatory Palestine who studied Zoology in Berlin. Barasch helped Mendelssohn to learn Hebrew. After the National Socialist Party's takeover of governmental power in 1933 and the experience of anti-Semitic defamation at the University, Mendelssohn decided to immigrate to Mandatory Palestine. His parents and sister joined him in 1935.

In Mandatory Palestine Mendelssohn continued his studies and training to become a Zoologist. He completed both his Msc and PhD in Zoology at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem under the supervision of Shimon Fritz Bodenheimer ("the first Hebrew Zoologist") with studies on ecological aspects of the Salamander (The thesis was titled "Die Anpassungsfähigkeit der Schwanzlurche") and the bird population of Israel (The dissertation was titled "אובולוסיות על הסתכלות" – "A Survey of the Bird Populations in Erez Israel"). During the 1930s and 1940s, Mendelssohn spent much time in research expeditions and fieldwork throughout the region of "Erez Israel", carefully documenting the wildlife in his new environment both in writing and photography. In the course of his expeditions, he and his colleague and friend Heinz Steinitz discovered a new species of frog, the *Latonia nigriventer*, endemic to the Hula wetlands in 1940. Mendelssohn also participated in the 1945 *Umm Rashrash Journey*, a famous exploration expedition of several Zionist organizations, which was aimed at surveying the South of Mandatory Palestine, a land yet unknown to them. In 1935 Mendelssohn joined Yehoshua Margolin at the Tel Aviv Biological-Pedagogical Institute, a center aimed at training teachers in natural sciences subjects. There he seems to have met his future wife, Tamar Pressman. After Margolin's death in 1947, Mendelssohn was appointed head of the institute, which became an important center of activity for nature lovers.

Under Mendelssohn's management, the institute played a crucial role in the birth of environmental action in the first years of the State of Israel: It was at the institute's zoological garden in 1940 that Mendelssohn met Amotz Zahavi who became his student and, later, a renowned zoologist and environmentalist. In 1950, Mendelssohn and a group of scientists from the Zoological Society and the Botanical Society formed the Joint Committee for Nature Protection, Israel's first environmental organization. In the early 1950s, Mendelssohn, Amotz Zahavi and colleagues from the Joint Committee for Nature Protection became major protagonists in Israel's first large scale environmental controversy: the preservation of the Hula wetland from development plans. Following this experience, Mendelssohn served as the first chairman of the Society for the Protection of Nature in Israel. As his correspondence reveals, he also campaigned for nature protection at state level and was engaged in several legislative efforts to protect the environment, including the Wildlife Protection Law from 1955. At the beginning of the 1960s, Mendelssohn was involved in the establishment of the Nature Reserve Authority (later renamed the Israel Nature and Parks Authority). His papers – especially correspondence and reports from the late 1960s until the early 2000s – attest to his continuous preoccupation with the work of this governmental agency. Even on an international level, Mendelssohn was involved in environmentalist causes. He was an active member of several specialist groups of the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) and maintained a vast network of correspondence with international colleagues in Asia, Africa, Europe, North- and South America for these causes.

As one of the founding faculty members of the Tel Aviv University, Mendelssohn also played a major role in the development of higher education in Israel. When Tel Aviv University was established in 1956 by consolidating existing research institutes, the Biological-Pedagogical Institute became the core of its Natural Sciences Faculty. As manager of the institute Mendelssohn became the faculty's first dean. He was appointed vice-president of the University in 1965, however, within a few months Mendelssohn abdicated this position in order to promote the development of the Zoology Department and his research. His main focus areas were faunistic and ecological research. An

extensive amount of observation records, notes, articles and entire subject files on various species of wildlife provide insight into this part of Mendelssohn's scientific work. As chair of the Zoology Department and one of its most experienced scientists, Mendelssohn was involved in educating generations of students, many of which became his colleagues over the years.

Mendelssohn received many prizes and honors – including the Bialik Prize, the Weizmann Prize, the Israel Prize and the German Federal Cross of Merit (“Bundesverdienstkreuz”). Due to his environmental activism beyond academic work, he became regarded as “the father of nature protection in Israel”. Heinrich Mendelssohn died in Tel Aviv at the age of 92 on the 19th of November, 2002.

3 SCOPE AND CONTENTS

Heinrich Mendelssohn's papers were transferred from his home to the Archives for the History of Tel Aviv University after his death in 2002. The collection reflects mainly Mendelssohn's academic work, teaching and research in the zoology department at the university, as well as involvement in various environmental projects, committees and campaigns, especially through his professional involvement in the Nature Reserves Authority (the NRA, later renamed the Israel Nature and Parks Authority) the early days of its inception and establishment, as well as some biographical material. Textual materials from Mendelssohn's early days in Mandatory Palestine, and his beginnings in the Zoology department at Tel Aviv University are not extensive and include mainly photographs, and observations cards. In addition, it should be noted that despite Mendelssohn's significant role in the establishment of the Israeli Society of Nature Protection (SPNI), there is a relative dearth of material pertaining to the Society. The original order of Mendelssohn's files was kept wherever possible: Materials include, alongside official correspondence, manuscripts and various documents, extensive subject files organized by species, which contained various types of materials such as photographs, field measurements manuscripts and academic materials. Moreover, correspondence files were kept in different series, as close as possible to Mendelssohn's organization, with several correspondence files organized by geographic locations, whereas others are organized chronologically, or separately by institution. This decision stemmed from the attempt to make accessible Mendelssohn's meticulous organization method, which reflects his vast research interests and encyclopedic knowledge of the zoological species in Israel.

Note on the marking of files: File titles with consecutive roman numerals refer to different files which hold the same names whereas titles with consecutive Arabic numerals belong to one original folder that was separated due to its size. Titles written in quotation marks reflect the original file name given by Mendelssohn himself and were preserved this way in order to reflect his original intention and way of organization.

Series 1: Personal Materials

This series contains various biographical materials related to Mendelssohn's personal life and family, such as Mendelssohn's correspondence with his wife Tamar Pressman during his travels in Ethiopia (1958), official documents from Germany (including his birth certificate), passports from Israel (ca.1951–1994), identification cards, and several appointment calendars (1943–2001). Furthermore this series includes a stamp collection, papers on various awards and prizes awarded to Mendelssohn (such as the Israel Prize) as well as single letters by and to Yigal Alon, Haim Levanon, Yitzhak Navon, Shimon Peres, Reuma Weizmann. A travel diary/notebook documents excursions and field trips in which Mendelssohn took part as a member of the Zionist Youth Movements (Blau-Weiß and Kadimah) in Berlin in the early 1930's.

Series 2: Correspondence Files

The files in this series contain primarily professional correspondence between Mendelssohn and colleagues in academic institutions in Israel and abroad in the years 1950–2001. Mendelssohn organized his correspondence mainly according to geographical categories. However, some correspondence files are dedicated to specific institutions. They may indicate priorities in Mendelssohn's work and special or longtime collaborations. The archival arrangement reflects

Mendelssohn's original filing system and thus provides insight into Mendelssohn's knowledge organization. Noteworthy and/or frequent correspondents in this series are Jim Buskirk, Tamar Dayan, Richard Faust, Carl Gans, Al Gore, Asa Kasher, Yossi Leshem, Konrad Lorenz, Shimon Peres, Miriam Rothschild, Yossi Sarid, J. D. Skinner, Uri Tzon, Reuma Weizmann, Avraham Yoffe, Yoram Yom-Tov, and Amotz Zahavi.

Series 3: Scholarly Work of Heinrich Mendelssohn

This series includes Mendelssohn's Master's thesis "Die Anpassungsfähigkeit der Schwanzlurche" (1935) and his dissertation "Survey on Bird Populations in *Erez Israel*" (1939) (written in Hebrew) as well as various manuscripts by Mendelssohn, on a range of topics, from ethological research of species in Israel to environmental issues such as afforestation. Several files in this series include manuscripts and related research materials. Some files contain manuscripts by colleagues and students of Mendelssohn such as David Blank, Neil Bernard Greenberg, Thomas W. Schoener, J.D. Skinner, Louis L. Somma and Yoram Yom-Tov. Furthermore the series contains Mendelssohn's notebooks with observation records and field notes between the years 1932–1964 and several research files on various zoological species in Israel that were at the focus of Mendelssohn's research such as *Agama Sinita*, *Canis Lupus*, *Clamator*, *Gazella Gazella*, *Passer Moabiticus*, *Trionyx* and more. The latter comprise the bulk of material in this series. The files contain different materials such as photographs, correspondence on various issues regarding the species in question, articles by Mendelssohn and others. Some of them contain observation records, which span several decades. Taken together, these materials document Israel's nature and its changes in the 20th century (ca. 1930–1995). All files were kept intact to reflect original order and to provide insight into the materials Mendelssohn collected as (reusable) sources for scientific articles.

Series 4: Nature Reserves Authority (NRA)

Mendelssohn's involvement in the programmatic and administrative work of the NRA is reflected in extensive correspondence files, which range from 1965 to 2000, and include correspondence with different officials and colleagues, among others Uzi Paz, Uri Tzon, and Avraham Yoffe. Materials in this series include correspondence from 1967 between Mendelssohn and the Minister of Defense, Moshe Dayan, about plans for a Fauna survey in the newly occupied Golan Heights (File no. 25–6). Furthermore, there are subject files related to different committees in which Mendelssohn participated, on topics such as professional development and the establishment of new nature reserves. In addition, the series contains files on environmental projects and campaigns related to the NRA's agenda.

Series 5: University Teaching and Administration

This series contains correspondence pertaining to various issues regarding Tel Aviv University, including a number of files from 1965, when Mendelssohn acted as vice president of the university. Correspondents in this series include: Georg Haas, Asa Kasher, Israel Rokach, Amiram Shkolnik, Heinz Steiniz, Jacob Wahrman, and Yoram Yom-Tov. Other materials include promotion letters and recommendations for colleagues and students, administrative files regarding staff promotion and hiring, budget, files related to the zoological garden and museum, research proposals and grant applications and material for Mendelssohn's teaching. This series is divided into sub-series containing correspondence files (1965–2001); sub-series on administrative topics such as university committees and promotion documents (1964–1994); subject files related to Mendelssohn's teaching (1936–1982); and a sub-series devoted to the zoological garden (1949–2000).

Series 6: Environmental Issues

This series contains primarily subject files about various environmental campaigns in which Mendelssohn had been involved, in issues such as afforestation, the danger to natural habitats of species, pesticides and illegal hunting. Some of the files that constitute Mendelssohn's scholarly work, especially those pertaining to different zoological species, also contain material relevant to environmental campaigns and projects partaken by Mendelssohn (See series 3 – Scholarly Work of Heinrich Mendelssohn). The series is arranged into two sub-series, one being correspondence files on environmental issues (1959–2001), and the second sub-series comprising of subject files on different topics, including correspondence, photographs, lecture notes and articles, observations, and meeting protocols.

Series 7: Printed Matter

This series contains publications by Mendelssohn as well as newspaper clippings on Heinrich Mendelssohn and on various other topics. Furthermore, the series contains several files with

geographical maps and includes a small part of Mendelssohn's book collection. The books which were kept as part of the collection are those that reflect Mendelssohn's professional education from the years 1928–1940. These are usually text books which were published in Germany.

Series 8: Images, Audio-Visual Materials and Objects

This series includes materials in various media: photographs, slides, VHS tapes, contact sheets and films, mainly depicting different species for research and educational purposes. This material is catalogued and cross-referenced by various themes and divisions in Mendelssohn's card boxes, as well as diary documenting the borrowing of the material by various TAU faculty members: The contact sheets are divided into a rough zoological division, and match to card boxes which correspond to the contact sheets' numbers in a few different, at times overlapping, divisions of topic. The series also contains personal and family photographs of Mendelssohn, including family photograph albums from Germany in the years 1910–1930; images and photographs from Mendelssohn's different excursions in Palestine in the 1940s, Photographs of Mendelssohn and Tamar Pressman, Photographs from Mendelssohn's 90th birthday celebration, and from Mendelssohn's funeral. All images, audio-visual materials and objects in this series were kept as part of various media collections and comprise a large part of Mendelssohn's entire collection, a fact that sheds light to its importance in Mendelssohn's research and instruction.

This series also contains personal and professional objects such as Mendelssohn's microscope, different test tubes, honors and prizes as well as his pipe and mussels he collected.

Series 9: Collections of Others

Contains material from Prof. Chanan Levinson of the zoology department of TAU, including mainly appointment calendars of Levinson, as well as his CV and publication list; Works by Ernst Schmitz, as part of a research conducted by Yossi Leshem. Other materials concerning/by Yochanan Aharoni, Elazar Kochva, Zvi Sever, all related to Mendelssohn as students or colleagues. It is unclear when and why these materials were integrated into the papers of Heinrich Mendelssohn (by the creator of the fonds or by others).
